An Act requiring photographs on protective orders..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 209A, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is 2 hereby amended by inserting after the word "order.", in line 3, the following 2 sentences:-3 "Whenever an order is made permanent, the court shall cause a color photograph of the 4 defendant, or a color copy thereof, to be affixed to each certified copy transmitted pursuant to 5 section 7." The photograph shall be taken by the probation department during any appearance by 6 the defendant related to the issuance of the order.
