An Act relative to supplementary process.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1                   SECTION 1. Section 19 of chapter 185C of the General Laws, as appearing in  
2 the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding, after the phrase “which shall be paid by  
3 the party entering or filing the same”, in line 10, the following phrase:- “provided, however, that  
4 the fee charged for the entry of supplementary proceedings under chapter 224 shall be the same  
5 as in the district court”
