The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

Resolve creating a real estate and housing commission.

- 1 Resolved, SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, there
- 2 shall be a special commission for the purpose of studying and making recommendations
- 3 concerning issues related to real estate and housing, included but not limited to zoning,
- 4 foreclosure, homelessness, and landlord/tenant disputes. The commission, in formulating its
- 5 recommendations, shall take account of best practices and policies in other states and
- 6 jurisdictions.
- 7 SECTION 2. The commission shall include, The Secretary of the Executive Office of
- 8 Housing and Economic Development, the Undersecretary of Housing and Community
- 9 Development, three members of the Senate appointed by the Senate President and one appointed
- 10 by the Senate Minority Leader, three members of the House of Representatives appointed by the
- 11 Speaker of the House and one appointed by the House Minority Leader, three persons to be
- 12 named by the Governor, and a representative from each of the following organizations:
- 13 Massachusetts Coalition for the Homeless, the Massachusetts Association of Realtors,
- 14 MassLandlords, the Massachusetts Union of Public Housing Tenants, the Massachusetts Fair

- 15 Housing Center, and the Fair Housing Center of Greater Boston. The Secretary of the Executive
- 16 Office of Housing and Economic Development shall be designated the chairman of the
- 17 commission.
- SECTION 3. The commission shall submit a report to the Governor, the Speaker of the
- 19 House of Representative and the President of the Senate, and the Joint Committee on Housing no
- 20 later than 9 months after the passage of this Act setting forth the commission's conclusions on
- 21 how to improve the affordability and accessibility of housing.
