(2017-2018)**

An Act protecting public higher education student information.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 66 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 21 the
2 following section:-

3 Section 22: Public colleges and universities as defined in section 5 of chapter 15A shall
4 not be required to produce records defined as education records in the Family Education Rights
5 and Privacy Act, 20 U.S.C Section 11232g, at 34 C.F.R. 99.3, including education records
6 designated by the public colleges and universities as directory information as defined in FERPA
7 at 34 C.F.R 99.3.
