An Act relative to name changes and requests.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 1D of Chapter 46 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2008
- 2 Official Edition is hereby amended by inserting after the first sentence the following sentences:-
- 3 If a party to the marriage who has changed his or her name files a certified copy of the certificate
- 4 of marriage with the register or probate in the county where the parties were married or presently
- 5 reside, the register of probate shall issue a certificate of change of name to the party who has
- 6 changed his or her name in accordance with the certificate of marriage. No fee shall be charged,
- 7 nor shall the party seeking the certificate of name change be required to file a petition for a name
- 8 change. Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 262, sections 34 and 40, the city or town
- 9 registrar or clerk, or the register of probate shall not charge any fees for fulfilling the duties set
- 10 forth in this section.
