Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 279 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 14 and 15, the words "such
- 3 suspension is revoked, the sentence shall be in full force and effect" and inserting in place
- 4 thereof the following:- the defendant violates a condition of probation, the court may (a)
- 5 continue him on probation with or without extending the term or modifying or enlarging the
- 6 conditions; or (b) revoke the sentence of probation and commit the defendant to an intermediate
- 7 sanctions program or impose all or any portion of the suspended sentence.
