#### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to parole eligibility.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 129D of Chapter 127, as it appears in the 2012 Edition of the
- 2 General Laws, is hereby amended by striking "5" in line 14 and inserting in place thereof "10";
- and by striking "10" wherever it appears and inserting in place thereof "20".
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 128 of Chapter 127, as so appearing, is hereby amended by adding
- 5 the following sentence:-
- Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the parole eligibility date for
- 7 house of correction inmates shall be 1/3 of the total aggregate term of incarceration or two years,
- 8 whichever is shorter.
- 9 SECTION 3. The parole board shall update its existing regulations and promulgate any
- 10 new regulations necessary in accordance with this act.
