An Act relative to supplementary process.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 19 of chapter 185C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding, after the phrase "which shall be paid by the 3 party entering or filing the same", in line 10, the following phrase:- "provided, however, that the 4 fee charged for the entry of supplementary proceedings under chapter 224 shall be the same as in 5 the district court"
