AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REMOVAL OR TRANSPORTATION OF TRASH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 31A of Chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking in lines 4-6 the following words: “; provided,  
3   however, that no rules or regulations shall restrict the hours of the day when garbage, offal or  
4   other offensive substances may be collected in areas zoned for business, commercial or industrial  
5   use”
