*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1. Section 9 of Chapter 211B, paragraph (xxii) is hereby amended by inserting in  
2 line 10 after the word “days”, and before the words, “the first justice,” the following:

3 Provided further, that no transfer of an assistant clerk/magistrate be made without the  
4 prior approval of such assistant clerk/magistrate’s appointing authority, the clerk/magistrate’s  
5 appointing authority, the clerk/magistrate of that particular division.
