An Act relative to supplementary process.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 19 of chapter 185C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding, after the phrase “which shall be paid by the party  
3 entering or filing the same”, in line 10, the following phrase:- “provided, however, that the fee  
4 charged for the entry of supplementary proceedings under chapter 224 shall be the same as in the  
5 district court”
