Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 12 of Chapter 202 is hereby amended by deleting in the first
2 sentence the words:- or in the case of a person incapacitated by reason of mental illness. Section
3 12 of Chapter 202 is hereby further amended, by deleting in the first sentence the words:- or in
4 the case of a person incapacitated by reason of mental illness to the department of mental health.
