AN ACT RELATIVE TO MEDICAL MALPRACTICE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 2 of Chapter 112 of the General Laws, is amended by inserting after  
2 paragraph seven the following:- Notwithstanding any general or specific law to the contrary, if a  
3 registered physician is convicted of three cases of medical malpractice the board shall revoke  
4 said physicians registration revoked.
