An Act relative to unemployment insurance rates.

*Whereas*, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is forthwith to lower the cost of unemployment insurance , therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 14 of chapter 151A of the General Laws, the  
2 experience rate of an employer qualifying therefor under subsection (b) of said section 14 of said  
3 chapter 151A shall be the rate which appears in column “E” in clause (1) of subsection (i) of said  
4 section 14 of said chapter 151A for calendar year 2011.

5           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of January 1, 2011.
