An Act relative to the criminal history systems board.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1. Chapter 6 of Section 168A of the general laws, as so appearing, is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after the word justices, the following, "clerk magistrates and assistant  
3 clerks".

4 Section 2. Chapter 276 of Section 100 of the general laws, as so appearing, is hereby  
5 amended by inserting after the word justices, the following, "clerk magistrates and assistant  
6 clerks".
