An Act relative to injuries to law enforcement personnel by drivers under the influence of alcohol.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 24D of Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding at the end  
2 thereof the following:-

3 This section shall not apply to any person who caused any injury to any law enforcement  
4 personnel during the events that gave rise to the complaint or indictment for operating under the  
5 influence of alcohol.
