## AN ACT CODIFYING THE HEPATITIS C PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2002 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after section 4L the following new section:-
- 3 Section 4M. Program to Combat Hepatitis C
- 4 (a) The department shall, subject to appropriation, establish and maintain a program to mitigate
- 5 the impacts of hepatitis C. The program shall provide screening, information, education and
- 6 treatment components, and may include research grants. The program shall increase public
- 7 awareness of hepatitis C and such efforts shall be undertaken in multiple languages and in a
- 8 culturally appropriate manner. The program shall provide information to health care providers
- 9 about risks, available prevention methods, and treatment options for hepatitis C.
- 10 (b) The program, to the extent the department determines feasible and appropriate, shall be
- integrated with substance abuse, HIV/AIDS and sexually transmitted disease service programs.

- 12 (c) The department may accept for the purposes of the program any special grant of money,
- services or property from the federal government or any of its agencies or from any foundation,
- 14 medical school or other organization.
