The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to remedial course vouchers for students impacted by COVID-19.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. The department of higher education shall provide all currently enrolled
- 2 public school students with a voucher for the cost of one year of remedial courses at a state or
- 3 community college listed in section 5 of chapter 15A or vocational-technical education school
- 4 defined in chapter 74. For the purposes of this section, "remedial course" shall mean an entry-
- 5 level college course designed to bring students to an academic level of performance needed to
- 6 succeed in college and the workforce, including, but not limited to, subjects on math, reading,
- 7 writing, vocational skills, career readiness, and personal finance. Remedial courses shall not
- 8 carry academic credits.
- 9 SECTION 2. The department shall develop and implement a voucher distribution plan in
- accordance with this act within six months of its passage and subject to appropriation.
