An Act relative to Forest Hills Cemetery..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 6 of the Chapter Fifty-seven of the Acts of Eighteen Hundred and Sixty-eight is  
2 hereby amended by striking out in the second line the words, “fourth Monday of March”, and  
3 inserting in place thereof, the words, “second Monday of May”, so that said Section 6 reads in its  
4 entirety as follows:

5           “The annual meetings of said corporation shall be held on the second Monday of May  
6 in each year, at such place in the city of Boston as the trustees shall direct, and notices thereof,  
7 signed by the secretary, shall be published in tow or more of the newspapers printed in Boston, at  
8 least seven days before the meeting; special meetings may be called by the trustees in the same  
9 manner. At all meetings of said corporation a quorum for business shall consist of not less than  
10 fifteen members, either present in person or represented by proxy, and any business may be  
11 transacted, of which notice shall be given in the advertisements for the meeting, and all questions

12 shall be decided by a majority of the members present and represented, and voting either in  
13 person or by proxy.”
