An Act to permit the setting of both cash bail and pretrial conditions in domestic violence matters..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 42A of Chapter 276 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
2 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended, in line 7, after the words “terms of” by inserting the
3 following: “bail or”.

4 SECTION 2. Section 58B of said Chapter 276 is hereby amended, in line 2, after the
5 words “pursuant to” by inserting the following: “section 42A or”.

6 SECTION 3. Section 58B of said Chapter 276 is hereby amended, in line 2, after the
7 words “section 58A”; by inserting the following: “or section 87”.
