An Act relative to PEG access and cable-related funds.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 53F<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of chapter 44 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 6, after the word “municipality” the  
3   following:- “. A municipality may also direct payment of franchise related fees by a cable  
4   operator to a designated PEG Access provider of its choosing.”.

5           SECTION 2. Said section 53F<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by striking  
6   out, in line 7, the word “appropriated” and inserting in place thereof the word “expended”.

7           SECTION 3. Chapter 352 of the Acts of 2014 shall be amended by adding at the end  
8   thereof the following new section:- “SECTION 3. This section shall take effect on July 1, 2020.”
