An Act relative to the commission of a crime while in possession of a police scanner..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 266 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1990 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after section 49 the following section:-
- 3 Section 49A. Whoever, while in the commission of a crime, knowingly has in their
- 4 possession a police scanner with the intent to use or employ said scanner to aid in the
- 5 commission of such crime shall be punished by imprisonment in the state prison for not more
- 6 than ten years or by a fine of not more than one thousand dollars and imprisonment in jail for not
- 7 more than two and one-half years.
