**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to protections for good samaritans.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 34A of chapter 94C is hereby amended by adding, after subsection (e), the
2 following subsection:-

3 “(f) A person acting in good faith may provide, administer, or utilize a narcotic testing
4 product to assist another person in determining whether a narcotic or substance contains
5 chemicals, toxic substances, or hazardous compounds. A person who, in good faith, provides,
6 administers, or utilizes a narcotic testing product to assist another person in determining whether
7 a narcotic or substance contains chemicals, toxic substances, or hazardous compounds shall not
8 be charged or prosecuted for possession of a controlled substance under sections 34 or 35 if the
9 evidence for the charge of possession of a controlled substance was gained as a result of
10 providing, administering, or utilizing a narcotic testing product to provide assistance to another
11 person. Narcotic testing products shall include, but not be limited to, fentanyl test strips.”
