An Act revising the charitable immunity cap.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Section 85K of Chapter 231 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2 official edition, is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof  
3 the following sentence:-

4           It shall not constitute a defense to any cause of action based on tort brought against a  
5 corporation, trustees of a trust, or members of an association that said corporation, trust or  
6 association is or at the time the cause of action arose was a charity; provided, that if (a) the tort  
7 was committed in the course of any activity carried on to accomplish directly the charitable  
8 purposes of such corporation, trust or association, (b) such corporation, trust or association  
9 derives more than fifty percent of its income from charitable gifts or donations, and (c) such

- 10 charitable corporation, trust or association had fewer than 25 employees at the time such cause of
- 11 action arose.
