An Act relative to benefits for court officers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding the provisions of any special or general law to the contrary, any court  
2 officer regularly and permanently employed by the trial court who transferred from any county  
3 sheriff's department on or after January 1, 1998, shall be entitled to have his years of prior  
4 service during which he was regularly and permanently employed by that sheriff's department  
5 count toward his vacation benefits in the trial court.
