## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act empowering zoning boards of appeals.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 40B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, after section 21, the following new section:-
- 3 Section 21A. During hearings and appeals held by a zoning board of appeals regarding
- 4 low or moderate income housing projects seeking a comprehensive permit, members of the
- 5 zoning board of appeals may raise and argue all relevant concerns without restriction.
- 6 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
