Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 123 of Chapter 266 is hereby amended by inserting at the end

- Whoever knowingly, willfully, or wantonly trespasses upon a state highway without just
- 4 cause may be held liable in a civil proceeding. Just cause shall include but not be limited to a
