Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 150A: 1 in the sixth paragraph section (a) of the Massachusetts General Laws is
2 hereby amended to include the words “professional and” in line 53 after the word “their”; and
3 again add the words “professional and” in section (b) line 54 after the words “to protect the right
4 of”

5 Chapter 150A:2, paragraph (3) is hereby amended by adding the word “professional” in
6 line 22 after the word “nurse”.

7 Chapter 151A:6 (r) line 119 through 123 is hereby deleted.
