In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act to amend G.L. c. 221 § 27A: Obsolete or useless papers; disposition, destruction or storage.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 27A of Chapter 221 of the General Laws, as amended by Section 124 of Chapter
- 2 46 of the Acts of 2015, is hereby further amended in paragraph (1) by adding at the end there of
- 3 the following:- "The Supreme Judicial Court may by rule or order make exceptions to this ten
- 4 year retention requirement for papers filed in or relating to matters involving alleged violations
- of laws, rules or regulations regarding motor vehicle civil infractions, motor vehicle parking,
- 6 littering, bicycles, pedestrians, municipal dog control, or non-criminal dispositions of municipal
- 7 ordinance or by-law violations, or other non-criminal regulatory offenses."
