An Act relative to vehicle recalls.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 7A of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the words “exhaust system.” in line 40, the following  
3 sentences: -

4           “Each inspection facility, while performing the vehicle inspection, shall provide notice of  
5 any open manufacture recalls in a form and manner prescribed by the registrar.”
