An Act limiting time period parking lots can remain open.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Whenever the operation of a permanent entertainment venue with seating for thirty  
2 thousand or more persons is subcontracted for a single use event from an existing user or owner,  
3 the duration of operation of its parking areas shall be limited to a period of two hours prior to the  
4 start time of the event through two hours following the end of the event, excluding any  
5 educational venue or a venue that is subcontracted out for a high school, college or university  
6 event.
