In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to protections for good samaritans.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 34A of chapter 94C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018

4 (f) A person acting in good faith may provide, administer, or utilize a controlled

substance testing product to assist another person in determining whether a controlled substance

contains chemicals, toxic substances, or hazardous compounds. A person who, in good faith,

7 provides, administers, or utilizes a controlled substance testing product to assist another person

in determining whether a controlled substance contains chemicals, toxic substances, or hazardous

compounds shall not be charged or prosecuted for possession of a controlled substance under

section 34 if the evidence for the charge of possession of a controlled substance was gained as a

- result of providing, administering, or utilizing a controlled substance testing product to provide
- 12 assistance to another person. Controlled substance testing products shall include, but not be
- limited to, fentanyl test strips.
- SECTION 2. Section 32I of said chapter 94C is hereby amended by adding, after
