AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1025  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in lines 2, 3, and 11, in each instance, strike “Reciprocity of”; in line 5, strike “a”; in the same line, strike “request” and substitute “requests”; and in line 10, after the semicolon, insert “stating the intent of the General Assembly that the Task Force constitute a commission to study and make recommendations concerning revision and amendments to the Potomac River Compact of 1958, as described in a certain section of the Compact.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 15, strike “Reciprocity of”; and after line 21, insert:

“(3) The Governor shall request that the Potomac River Fisheries Commission appoint at least one member to the Task Force.”.

On page 2, strike beginning with “Virginia” in line 1 down through “Secretary’s” in line 2 and substitute “Commissioner of the Virginia Marine Resources Commission, or the Commissioner’s”; in line 15, strike the second “and”; and in line 17, after “reciprocity” insert “; and

“(4) actions the Potomac River Fisheries Commission can take, consistent with the Interstate Wildlife Violator Compact, to prohibit a person from participating in a fishery under the Potomac River Fisheries Commission’s jurisdiction if the person’s license to catch, sell, buy, process, transport, export, or otherwise deal in fish in Maryland has been suspended or revoked”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, after line 20, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the General Assembly that the Task Force established by this Act constitute a commission to study and make recommendations concerning revision and amendments to the Potomac River Compact of 1958, as described in Article IV, Section 5, of the Compact.”;

and in line 21, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”.
