AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 276

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 15, after “confinement;” insert “requiring the Division of Correction to deny certain privileges to certain inmates;”.

On page 2, after line 12, insert:

“BY adding to

Article - Correctional Services

Section 9-614

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2008 Replacement Volume and 2012 Supplement)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 5, after line 22, insert:

“9-614.

(A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE DIVISION OF CORRECTION MAY NOT PROVIDE AN INMATE WHO IS SERVING A SENTENCE OF LIFE WITHOUT PAROLE WITH THE FOLLOWING PRIVILEGES DURING THE INCARCERATION OF THE INMATE:

(1) ACCESS TO TELEVISION OR THE INTERNET;

(2) EDUCATIONAL SERVICES;

(3) ACCESS TO A LIBRARY; OR

(Over)

(4) MEETINGS WITH VISITORS TO THE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY.

(B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO REASONABLE ACCESS TO LEGAL COUNSEL.”.
