10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)							

"Providing arts opportunities for all through exceptional dance education, community outreach, and inspiring performances." This statement reflects the goals of excellence and

service to our community in MBT's 3 program areas- Academy, Outreach, and Productions. MBT achieves its mission by: 1) Offering professional dance education to all students regardless of age, body type, technical ability, physical limitations, previous experience, future aspirations, or financial means; 2) Community outreach. Students and MBT's professional company perform to schools, assisted living centers, and others who may not otherwise experience live dance. To remain accessible, ticket prices for MBT's professional ballets remain the lowest in the County, and we offer a free ticket giveaway program; and 3) Fostering self-confidence through professional performing opportunities.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

MBT, founded in 1989, occupies approximately 7,700 sqft in Gaithersburg, with three classroom studios. MBT is undertaking an expansion project to build similar facilities in Clarksburg. The project will cost approximately \$550K. Approximately \$350K is already secured. MBT provides exceptional dance education, community outreach, and inspiring performances. Currently, no ballet school with professional performing opportunities and a robust community service program exists between our Gaithersburg location and Frederick, MD. MBT hopes to fill that geographic void in the upcounty, while also alleviating capacity pressure in Gaithersburg classes, providing more arts education opportunities in the upcounty region. The new space will consist of three classroom studio spaces, office space, small storage space, restrooms/changing areas, and a waiting area. The space is 7,086sq ft. We intend to be open for the start of the 2018-2019 school year.

MBT is currently exploring an opportunity to expand into the upcounty with a second location in Clarksburg. Our staff and Board of Directors have been discussing for 1.5 years the need to alleviate capacity constraints at our Gaithersburg studios. After several geographic trend studies of our student body, financial assessments, and board workshops, we decided to pursue an additional upcounty location in the next 1-3 years. The opportunity arose more quickly than anticipated for a perfectly-located space, and we are excited for the possibilities that this expansion will provide to our students and community. Currently, no ballet school with professional performing opportunities and a robust community service program exists between our current location in Gaithersburg and Frederick. MBT hopes to fill that void, while alleviating some capacity pressure in Gaithersburg's classes. Fortunately, MBT is financially stable and able to pursue this opportunity in a time frame agreeable to the property owner.
