Capital Equipping of old wood shop to be turned into "MAKER SPACE" with tools, software to run machinery, 3D design and graphics as well as renovation to space and entrance for visibility. In Anne Arundel County the schools are used simultaneously as community centers through a collaboration with Recreation and Parks. CAC is part of Brooklyn Park Middle School, a performing arts magnet school. It is the only "community arts center in North Anne Arundel County. The purpose of the project is to bring new programs to help at risk students realize their full potential through tools, innovation and imagination. The development of after school programs are much needed in North County to bring at-risk students into a safe environment to learn skills hands on, from instructors, engineers, and mentors that will prepare them for future employment. Skills that are related to STEAM, (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math). CAC can be a catalyst for change in helping to prevent student from engaging in unwholesome activities that occur from 3:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. CAC strongly believes it is much easier to prevent broken lives than to repair them.
