## **10. Description and Purpose of Organization** (Limit length to visible area)

The Somerset County Historical Society is a 501(c)3 charitable organization that owns and operates the Teackle Mansion and the Sarah Martin Done house as a historic site open to the public during regular tours and special events throughout the year. The Somerset County Historical Society (SCHS) sponsors educational programming during two periods during the calendar year. In 1996, realizing that taking on a large scale restoration was not feasible for their resources, the SCHS facilitated the creation of a second organization, the Friends of Teackle Mansion, Inc. as a fund-raising subsidiary to target m for the restoration needs of this two-hundred year old landmark building that is one of the architectural and historical centerpieces to the lower Eastern Shore region.

## 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The bond bill application addresses a range of restoration, construction and purchasing equipment for the Teackle Mansion and the Sarah Martin Done House, both of which are owned by the Somerset County Historical Society. The projects for the mansion include masonry, carpentry and electrical related projects to improve the property as a publically accessible historic site holding regular tours, educational programs, and special events. The range of work would address relaying 2000 sq. ft. of historic sidewalks, rebuilding a set of front steps, exterior repointing and rebuilding of the south wing chimney, design and installation of exterior lighting for pubic safety and events, lead paint removal and repainting of interior spaces in historic color schemes as well as improvements to upgrade the Sarah Martin Done house as an auxiliary meeting and event space.
