1 AN ACT concerning

Public Buildings - Changing Facilities for Adult Diapers - Personal Care for Adults

- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring, except under certain circumstances, that a diaper-changing facility changing facilities suitable for changing the diaper of a child and providing 5 6 personal care for an adult be installed in certain public restrooms in certain public 7 buildings on or before a certain date; requiring certain entities responsible for the 8 enforcement of this Act to report to the Department of General Services 2-1-1 9 Maryland, Inc., the location of a diaper-changing facility suitable for changing the diaper of an adult changing facilities when the diaper-changing facility is changing 10 facilities are installed; requiring the Department 2-1-1 Maryland, Inc., to maintain 11 12 on its website a list containing all the locations of certain diaper-changing changing facilities; altering a certain definition; and generally relating to diaper-changing 13 14 changing facilities in public buildings.

- 19 (3) "Public building" does not include a facility that is primarily used to 20 provide primary or secondary education.
- 21 (d) "Public restroom" means a sanitary facility available to the general public that 22 contains at least one toilet or urinal.
- 23 (e) "Substantial renovation" means a construction or renovation project with an 24 estimated cost of \$30,000 or more.
