1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Video Lottery Terminals – Racetrack Facility Renewal Account – Allocation of**
3 **Funds**

4 FOR the purpose of adding a certain racing facility to the facilities eligible to receive a
5 certain allocation of funds from the Racetrack Facility Renewal Account; and
6 generally relating to the allocation of funds from the Race Track Facility Renewal
7 Account.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – State Government**

21 9–1A–29.

22 (a) There is a Racetrack Facility Renewal Account under the authority of the
23 State Racing Commission.

1 (d) The amount of funds made available from the Racetrack Facility Renewal
2 Account shall be allocated as follows:

3 (1) 80% to the Pimlico Race Course, Laurel Park, **THE BOWIE RACE**
4 **COURSE TRAINING CENTER**, and the racecourse at Timonium; and

5 (2) 20% to Rosecroft Raceway and Ocean Downs Race Course.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
7 October 1, 2019.
