A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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State Fire Marshal - Investigations - Reporting Requirement

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Fire Marshal to report to the Public Service 4 Commission with an update of a certain investigation within a certain number of 5 days after a fire or explosion or attempt to cause a fire or explosion; requiring the 6 State Fire Marshal to provide the Commission with subsequent updates on the 7 investigation within a certain number of days after the previous update until the 8 investigation is concluded; requiring an update to include the status of the 9 investigation and the expected date on which the investigation will conclude; and generally relating to investigations of a fire or explosion or attempt to cause a fire or 10 11 explosion.

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 21 (a) At any time, the State Fire Marshal may investigate the origin or 22 circumstances of a fire or explosion or an attempt to cause a fire or explosion that occurs in
- 23 the State.
- 24 (b) At any time, the State Fire Marshal:



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1 2	(1) may enter into and examine a building or premises where a fire is burning or where a fire or attempt to cause a fire has occurred;
3 4	(2) may enter into a building or premises adjacent to a building or premises where a fire or attempt to cause a fire has occurred; and
5 6 7	(3) may take full control and custody of the building or premises and place an individual that the State Fire Marshal considers proper in charge of the building or premises, until the examination and investigation of the State Fire Marshal is completed.
8 9 10	(C) (1) THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL SHALL REPORT TO THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION WITH AN UPDATE OF AN INVESTIGATION CONDUCTED UNDER THIS SECTION:
11 12	(I) WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER THE FIRE OR EXPLOSION OR ATTEMPT TO CAUSE A FIRE OR EXPLOSION; AND
13 14	(II) EVERY 90 DAYS THEREAFTER UNTIL THE INVESTIGATION IS CONCLUDED.
15	(2) THE UPDATE SHALL INCLUDE:
16	(I) THE STATUS OF THE INVESTIGATION; AND
17 18	(II) THE EXPECTED DATE ON WHICH THE INVESTIGATION WILL CONCLUDE.
19 20	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2021.
