CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Calvert County – Alcoholic Beverages – Bottle Clubs – Prohibitions**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting in Calvert County an establishment commonly known
4 as a bottle club that is not licensed by the Board of License Commissioners from
5 giving, serving, dispensing, keeping, or allowing to be consumed on its premises
6 or on premises under its control or possession any alcoholic beverages;
7 establishing a certain penalty for a violation of this Act; and generally relating
8 to alcoholic beverages in Calvert County.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
21 MARYLAND, That Section(s) 20–103.1 of Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages of the
22 Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 20–103.2.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland
2 read as follows:

3 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

4 **20-103.1.**

5 **(A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN CALVERT COUNTY.**

6 **(B) AN ESTABLISHMENT COMMONLY KNOWN AS A BOTTLE CLUB THAT IS**
7 **NOT LICENSED BY THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY NOT GIVE,**
8 **SERVE, DISPENSE, KEEP, OR ALLOW TO BE CONSUMED ON ITS PREMISES OR ON**
9 **PREMISES UNDER ITS CONTROL OR POSSESSION ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.**

10 **(C) A PERSON THAT VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A**
11 **MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING**
12 **\$500.**

13 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
14 July 1, 2014.
