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## **Garrett County Alcoholic Beverages Act of 2022**

FOR the purpose of establishing a barbershop and beauty salon beer and wine license in
Garrett County; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Garrett County
to issue the license to a holder of a certain barbershop or beauty salon permit;
altering the maximum number of beer, wine, and beer and wine festival licenses that
may be issued in Garrett County and the maximum number of days the festivals
may be conducted; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Garrett County.

27 (b) (1) There is a Garrett County Beer and Wine Festival.

1 (2) Under the supervision of the Board, the festival organization may 2 conduct the Festival annually [on the second Saturday of September] FOR A FIXED 3 PERIOD OF TIME OF UP TO 3 CONSECUTIVE DAYS.

4 (c) (2) The Board may issue [one] NOT MORE THAN FOUR beer and wine 5 festival [license] LICENSES each year.

6 (h) (1) The Board shall choose a location for the festival that is not already 7 licensed.

8 (2) If the location chosen allows for Sunday sales, Sunday sales may begin 9 at 10 a.m.

11 (a) (1) There is a wine festival license.

12 (2) The Board may issue [one] NOT MORE THAN FOUR wine festival 13 [license] LICENSES each year.

14 (f) (1) Subject to paragraph (3) of this subsection, each year the Board shall 15 choose [1 or 2 days] **UP TO 3 CONSECUTIVE DAYS** for the wine festival.

16 (2) The Board shall choose a location that is not already licensed.

17 (3) A day chosen for the wine festival may not:

18 (i) be a Sunday; or

19 (ii) fall on the same weekend as the Maryland Wine Festival in20 Carroll County.

(g) Notwithstanding subsection (f)(3)(i) of this section, a holder of a wine festival
 license issued for use in a location where Sunday sales are allowed may make Sunday sales
 beginning at 10 a.m.
