Vehicle Laws - Rules of the Road - Authorized Turns on Red After Yielding

FOR the purpose of creating for certain authorized turns an exception to the requirement that vehicular traffic facing a steady circular red signal stop at the near side of the intersection at certain points; authorizing vehicular traffic facing a steady red signal to cautiously enter the intersection and make a right turn after yielding to any traffic coming from the left or a left turn from a one—way street onto another one—way street after yielding to any traffic coming from the right; and generally relating to authorized turns by vehicular traffic

facing a steady red signal.


