## Courts - Falsely Summoning a Police Officer - Civil Liability

- FOR the purpose of authorizing a person to bring a civil action for damages against another person who knowingly causes a police officer to arrive at a location to contact the person with a certain intent; establishing an exception in certain cases where a person who alleges to have been a victim of abuse requests the help of a police officer; and generally relating to civil liability for improperly summoning a police officer.
