5 6 7 8	(2) (i) Subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, "proceeds" does not include money given away by a video lottery operation licensee as free promotional play and used by players to bet in a video lottery terminal OR AT A TABLE GAME .			
9 10 11 12 13	(ii) After the first fiscal year of operations, the exclusion specified in subparagraph (i) of this paragraph may not exceed a percentage established by the Commission by regulation of the proceeds received from video lottery terminals AND TABLE GAMES in the prior fiscal year by the video lottery operation licensee under § 9–1A–27(a)(2), [and] (c)(1)(ii), AND (D)(1) of this subtitle.
