A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Health - Abortions - Reporting Requirements

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a physician who performs an abortion or certain hospitals, 4 facilities, and institutions in which an abortion is performed to report the abortion 5 to the Maryland Department of Health; requiring that the report be made on a 6 certain form, be completed by a certain physician, hospital, facility, or institution, be 7 transmitted annually to the Vital Statistics Administration within a certain period 8 of time, and include certain information; providing that the report may include 9 certain information but may not include certain identifying information; establishing 10 certain penalties; requiring the Department to adopt certain regulations; 11 authorizing the State Board of Physicians to take certain disciplinary actions against 12 a licensee who violates certain provisions of this Act; defining a certain term; and 13 generally relating to the reporting of information about abortions.

- 3 **(E) (1)** A PHYSICIAN WHO PERFORMS AN ABORTION AND FAILS TO SUBMIT THE REPORT REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IS 4 5 GUILTY OF UNPROFESSIONAL CONDUCT AND SHALL BE SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINARY 6 ACTION UNDER § 14-404 OF THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE.
- 7 **(2)** A PHYSICIAN OR AN INDIVIDUAL ACTING ON BEHALF OF A 8 HOSPITAL, A FACILITY, OR AN INSTITUTION WHO DOES NOT SUBMIT THE REPORT 9 REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO AN ADMINISTRATIVE FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500 FOR EACH VIOLATION. 10

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- Subject to the hearing provisions of § 14–405 of this subtitle, a disciplinary 15 16 panel, on the affirmative vote of a majority of the quorum of the disciplinary panel, may 17 reprimand any licensee, place any licensee on probation, or suspend or revoke a license if the licensee: 18
- 19 (44)Fails to meet the qualifications for licensure under Subtitle 3 of this 20 title; [or]
- 21(45)Fails to comply with § 1–223 of this article; **OR**
- 22(46) Fails to comply with § 20–217 of the Health – General 23 ARTICLE.
