- 3 FOR the purpose of limiting the application of a requirement that owners of residential,
- 4 detached units in a condominium regime carry homeowners insurance coverage to

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 Article Real Property
- 20 11–114.
- 21 (a) Commencing not later than the time of the first conveyance of a unit to a
- 22 person other than the developer, the council of unit owners shall maintain, to the extent
- 23 reasonably available:
- 24 (1) Property insurance against risks of direct physical loss commonly

- 1 insured against in amounts determined by the council of unit owners, but not less than any 2 amounts specified in the declaration or bylaws:
- 3 (i) For attached or multifamily dwelling units, on the common 4 elements and units, exclusive of improvements and betterments installed in units by unit 5 owners other than the developer; and
 - (ii) For detached units, on the common elements; and
- 7 (2) Comprehensive general liability insurance, including medical payments insurance, in an amount determined by the council of unit owners, but not less than any amount specified in the declaration or bylaws, covering occurrences commonly insured against for death, bodily injury, and property damage arising out of or in connection with the use, ownership, or maintenance of the common elements.
- 12 (e) (1) An insurance policy issued to the council of unit owners does not 13 prevent a unit owner from obtaining insurance for his own benefit.
- 14 (2) An owner of a residential, detached unit IN A CONDOMINIUM REGIME 15 COMPOSED SOLELY OF RESIDENTIAL, DETACHED UNITS shall carry homeowners 16 insurance coverage on the entirety of the unit.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2024.
