- 19 (a) (1) At least 30 days before any property is first advertised for sale under 20 this subtitle, the collector shall have mailed to the person who last appears as owner of the
- 21 property on the collector's tax roll, at the last address shown on the tax roll, a statement
- 22 giving the name of the person, and the amounts of taxes due.
