Election Law – Ballot Drop Boxes – Prohibited Acts

- FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from removing, defacing, damaging, destroying, or preventing the correct operation of a ballot drop box; prohibiting a person from unlocking a ballot drop box except under certain circumstances; providing that a

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article Election Law
- 16 **16–805.**
- 17 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "BALLOT DROP BOX" MEANS A SECURE, DURABLE,
- 18 OUTDOOR CONTAINER THAT IS OFFICIALLY DESIGNATED BY A LOCAL BOARD
- 19 EXCLUSIVELY FOR VOTERS TO DEPOSIT COMPLETED ABSENTEE BALLOTS IN
- 20 PERSON.
- 21 **(B)** A PERSON MAY NOT:
- 22 (1) REMOVE, DEFACE, DAMAGE, DESTROY, OR PREVENT THE
- 23 CORRECT OPERATION OF A BALLOT DROP BOX; OR



- 1 (2) EXCEPT FOR SERVICING BY AN AUTHORIZED PERSON, UNLOCK 2 ANY LOCKED COMPARTMENT OF A BALLOT DROP BOX UNLESS INSTRUCTED TO DO
- 3 SO BY THE ELECTION DIRECTOR.
- 4 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND
- 5 ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$10,000 OR
- 6 IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 3 YEARS OR BOTH.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 8 October 1, 2021.
