- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 27 (b) (1) Except as provided under [paragraph (2)] PARAGRAPHS (2) AND (3)
- 28 of this subsection, an individual may satisfy any requirement under this article to possess
- 29 or display a license [or], stamp, PERMIT, REGISTRATION, OR CERTIFICATE issued under
- 30 [§§ 4–604, 4–614, 4–745, or 10–301(g) of] this article by possessing or displaying the
- 31 document in a digital or electronic format as provided by the Department.

- 1 (2) [An annual special Chesapeake Bay and coastal sport fishing license 2 shall be permanently affixed to a boat in accordance with § 4–745(d)(2) of this article] 3 PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A LICENSE, STAMP, 4 PERMIT, REGISTRATION, OR CERTIFICATE LISTED IN SUBSECTION (A)(2) OF THIS 5 SECTION.
  - (3) NOTWITHSTANDING PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL IS STILL REQUIRED TO ATTACH, AFFIX, OR DISPLAY NUMBERS, STICKERS, OR DECALS ASSOCIATED WITH A LICENSE, STAMP, PERMIT, REGISTRATION, OR CERTIFICATE ON A VEHICLE, VESSEL, DOCK, OR GEAR AS REQUIRED UNDER THIS ARTICLE OR DEPARTMENT REGULATIONS.

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- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, if the Department of Natural Resources cannot issue certain licenses, stamps, permits, registrations, or certificates in a digital or electronic format because of federal restrictions, it is the intent of the General Assembly that the Department shall issue those licenses, stamps, permits, registrations, or certificates in a digital or electronic format whenever the federal government eliminates those restrictions.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2024.
